Technical Support

Becker College's IT department can provide basic support for the following systems:

The IT department cannot provide hardware or operating system support for student-owned computers. The IT department is also unable to provide any support for applications on student-owned computers other than helping you connect your device to the network. Computer Requirements

Required Antivirus Software

Antivirus software is required on any student computer that wants to gain access to the Becker College network. If you do not have an Antivirus program, the OIT department can provide or recommend one for you. For a full list of supported Anti-Virus programs, please review the Becker College OIT Website.

Connecting to the Network

Becker supports wireless & wired access in most Residence Halls except apartments (there is wireless only in Willow and Spruce); if you are living in one of these halls and have a desktop computer, please be sure to bring a <u>wireless adapter</u>. You must install Antivirus software and the OnGuard ClearPass Agent on laptops and desktops that access the wireless network. Please note that personal routers are <u>NOT</u> allowed in residence halls. If you plug in a wired or wireless router, it will be confiscated. Please bring a long Ethernet cable if you plan to use a wired connection in one of the wired ethernet capable residence halls.

E-mail and Microsoft Office

As part of your mymail.becker.edu e-mail account, you also receive free use of the full Office365 suite which includes email, Word, PowerPoint and Excel. Also included are tools like instant messaging, group video, voice chat and online document viewing and editing and also 1TB of cloud storage per user via your One Drive account.
