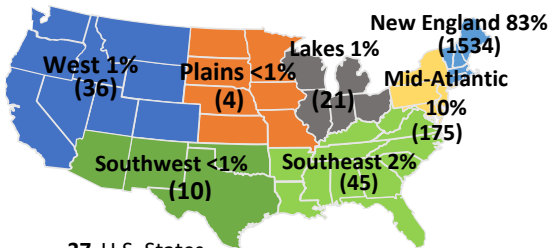

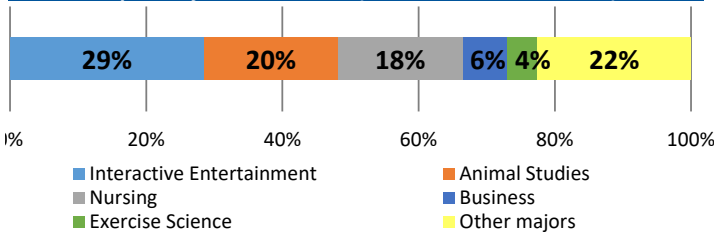

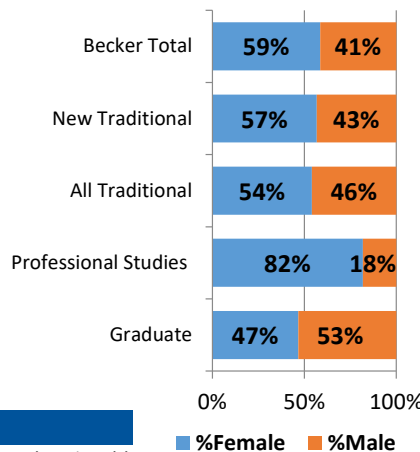

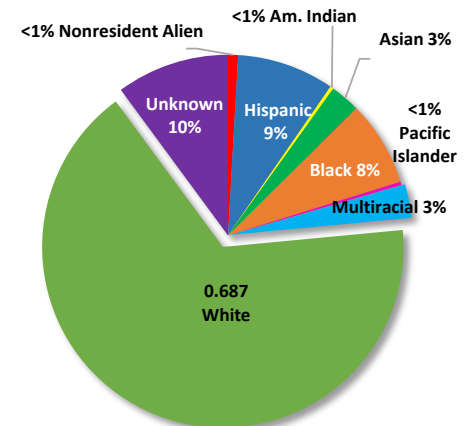
Top 5 Major Distribution (All Traditional Students)

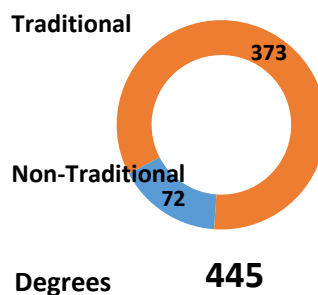
