To ensure the safety and comfort of all guests attending Commencement, attendees may be subject to a search upon entering the facility. Any bags measuring larger than 14" x 16" will NOT be permitted into the arena. For smaller bags, searches may also be conducted.

Knapsacks, luggage, coolers, parcels, and briefcases will NOT be allowed.

Accommodations for Guests with Disabilities

Guests with physical challenges should enter the lobby through door #13 where ushers will be available to assist them to appropriate seating.

A sign-language interpreter will be stationed on the stage during the ceremony. Those in need of this accommodation should sit in the arena's section 106.

Photography

Please be aware that a professional photographer has been hired for the Commencement ceremony; each graduate will be photographed receiving his or her diploma. You will receive information directly from the photographer about purchasing these photos. While we understand that you may wish to take your own close-up pictures, please be advised that the College must keep the aisles clear during the ceremony and no one, except for College personnel and the photographers who have been officially hired for this event, will be allowed near the stage. The ceremony will be videotaped and then posted on the College's website sometime after the event, and a press release will be sent to your hometown newspaper of your graduate.

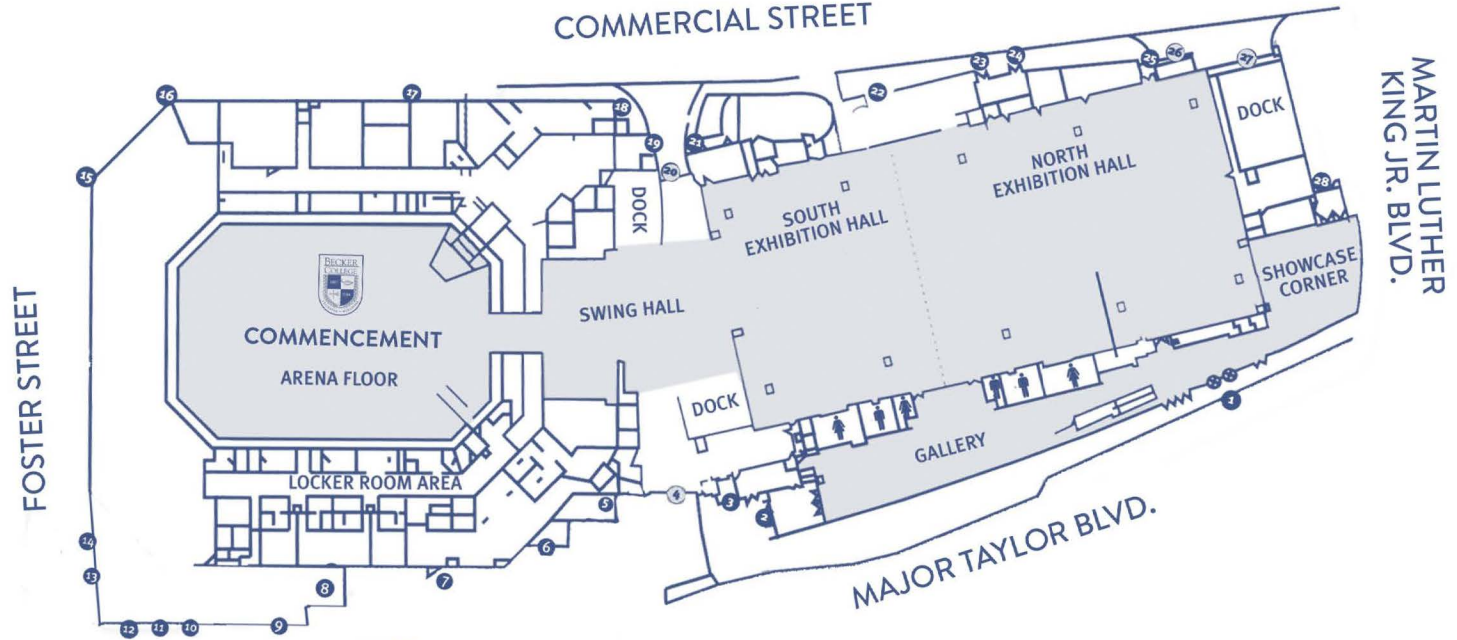
