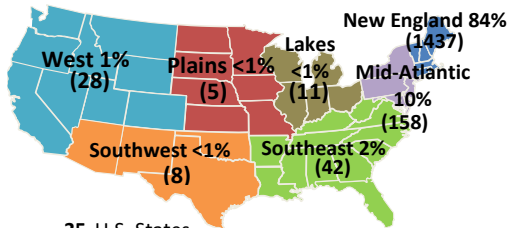

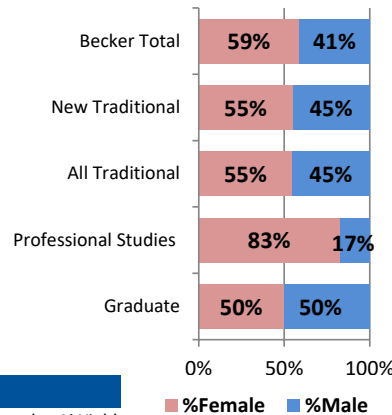

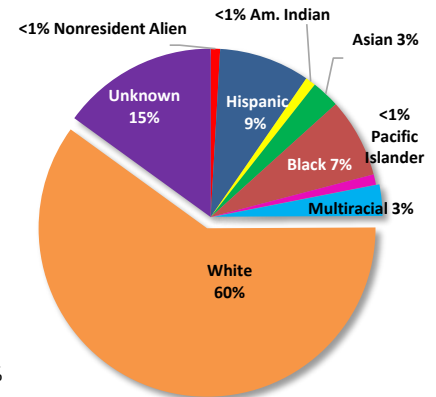

### Race/Ethnicity



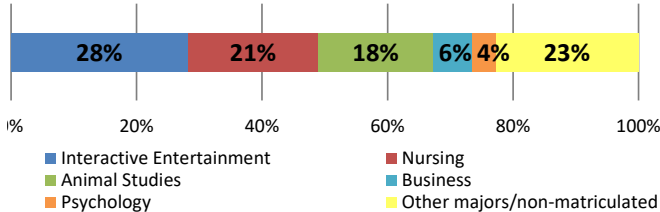

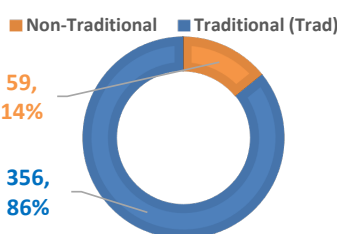
