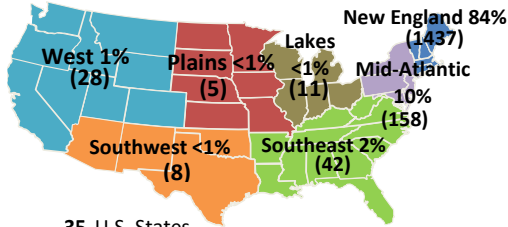

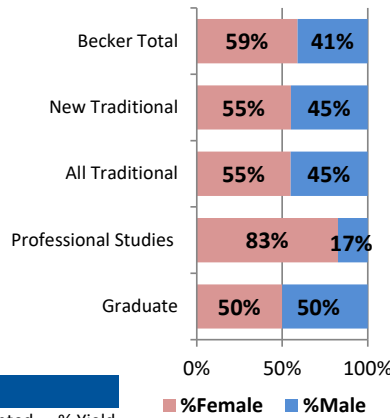

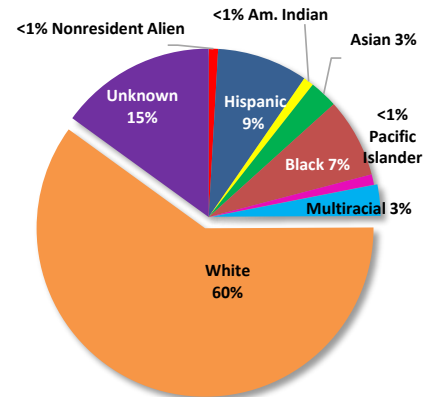

Race/Ethnicity



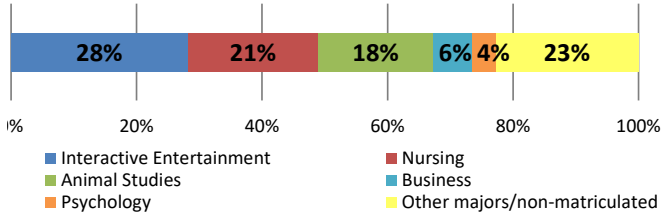

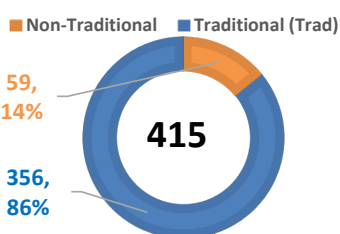

Degrees Awarded by Division*

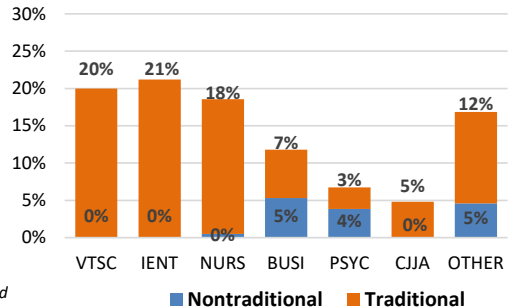
