

# Tuition Deferment

Tuition Deferment is only available to students in the GPS Program (Graduate and Professional Studies) at Becker College who have a tuition reimbursement agreement with their employer. The following **must** be submitted to the Office of Student Accounts prior to the start of your Fall and/or Spring classes:

- **\$75 fee for the semester that is being deferred (deferment fees cannot be transferred or refunded).**
- **A current statement of eligibility from the employee's Human Resources Dept. explaining the benefit and the amount that would be covered.**
- **This signed promissory note.**

Payment of Deferment Fees: You may pay deferment fees with cash, check, or money order at the Student Administrative Services Bldg. located at 47 Sever Street, Worcester, MA 01609. For quick processing, you may also log into your myBecker account and pay via credit/debit card (MasterCard, Visa, American Express, Discover) or by ACH (checking account) with no additional fee.

Terms & Conditions: The deferred due date is 30 days after the end of each class deferred. Any balance not covered by the employer is the responsibility of the student. If grades are required to obtain payment from the employer, it is solely the students responsibility to secure their grades and to submit to employer in a timely manner. Tuition may be paid in person at the 47 Sever St address, by logging into your myBecker account, or by mailing check or money order to: Becker College, Student Accounts, 61 Sever St, Worcester, MA 01609. If payment in full is not made by due date, a hold will be placed on your student account preventing any future registration and release of transcripts or diploma until the outstanding balance is paid. If the tuition deferment agreement goes into default, it becomes null and void, and the account is now subject to being referred to an outside collection agency for payment.

By signing below, I agree to all the above terms and conditions. Furthermore, by signing below, I agree that if my balance remains unpaid and my account is forwarded to a collection agency, I will be financially responsible for any and all collections costs and fees, including but not limited to attorney's fees, court costs, and other related costs associated with the collection. I understand by executing this tuition deferment, it creates a financial obligation between me and Becker College. If my employer fails to pay within the 30 day deferment period, I understand that payment in full is my responsibility. Official transcripts and diplomas will not be released until all balances are paid in full.
