Notes for Class of 2018:

The Class of 2018 data includes responses Senior Exit Survey, Alumni One-Year Out Survey, and data from the National Student Clearinghouse. The overall knowledge rate for the surveys for traditional students and all students were 75% (268/358) and 72% (321/448) correspondingly. With supplemental continuing education data from the National Student Clearinghouse, there is data on 84% (299/358) of the traditional students and 80% (358/448) of all graduates for the Class of 2018.

Results based on **valid percent, as reported above**, uses a denominator equal to the number of valid/known information collected about a graduating class. Percentages are not based on the whole class but rather only those we know something about. The valid percent for the Class of 2018 is 58% (172/299) for traditional students and 61% (219/358) for all students.

Results based on **total percent** uses the full graduating cohort as the denominator. Percentages are provided regardless of whether or not we actually know anything about their circumstances. The total percent for the Class of 2018 is 48% (172/358) for traditional students and 49% (219/448) for all students.

Notes for Class of 2017:

The Class of 2017 data includes responses Senior Exit Survey, Alumni One-Year Out Survey, and data from the National Student Clearinghouse. The overall knowledge rate for the surveys for traditional students and all students were 77% (272/352) and 72% (325/451) correspondingly. With supplemental continuing education data from the National Student Clearinghouse, there is data on 84% (294/352) of the traditional students and 79% (357/451) of all graduates for the Class of 2017.

Results based on **valid percent, as reported above**, uses a denominator equal to the number of valid/known information collected about a graduating class. Percentages are not based on the whole class but rather only those we know something about. The valid percent for the Class of 2017 is 60% (177/294) for traditional students and 64% (227/357) for all students.

Results based on **total percent** uses the full graduating cohort as the denominator. Percentages are provided regardless of whether or not we actually know anything about their circumstances. The total percent for the Class of 2017 is 50% (177/352) for traditional students and 50% (227/451) for all students.

Notes for Class of 2016:

The Class of 2017 data includes responses from Senior Exit Survey, the six month out survey, Alumni One-Year Out Survey, and data from the National Student Clearinghouse.

The Class of 2016 survey response rate for these three surveys was 23% for traditional students (91/400) and all students (115/500). With supplemental continuing education data from the National Student Clearinghouse, there is data on 35% (141/400) of the traditional students and 38% (188/500) of all graduates for the Class of 2016.

Results based on **valid percent, as reported above**, uses a denominator equal to the number of valid/known information collected about a graduating class. Percentages are not based on the whole class but rather only those we know something about. The valid percent for the Class of 2016 is 84% (119/141) for traditional students and 87% (163/188) for all students.

Results based on **total percent** uses the full graduating cohort as the denominator. Percentages are provided regardless of whether or not we actually know anything about their circumstances. The total percent for the Class of 2016 is 30% (119/400) for traditional students and 33% (163/500) for all students.
