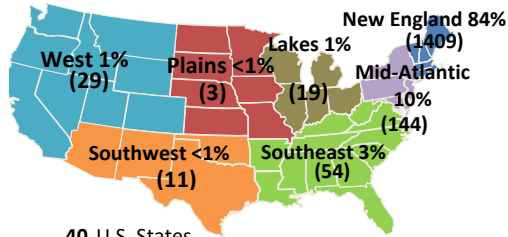

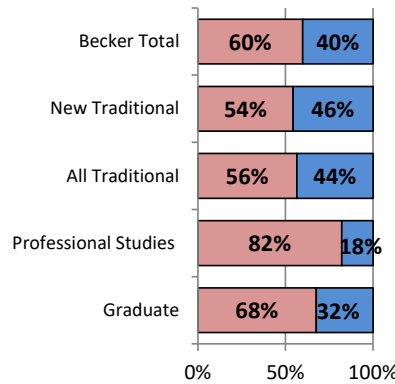

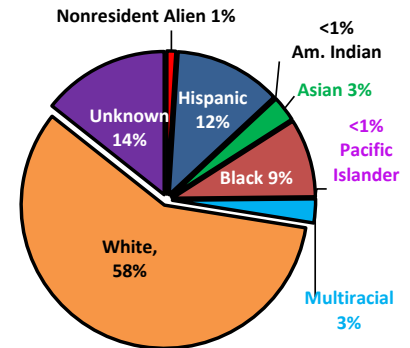

Race/Ethnicity

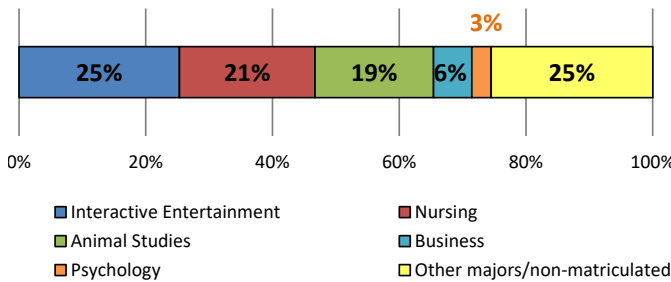

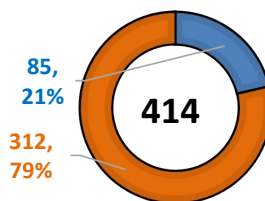
