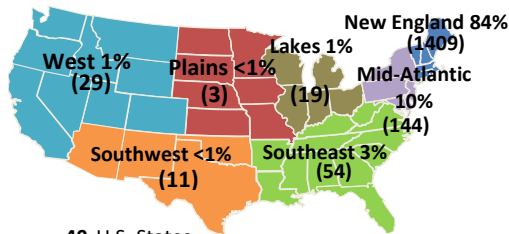

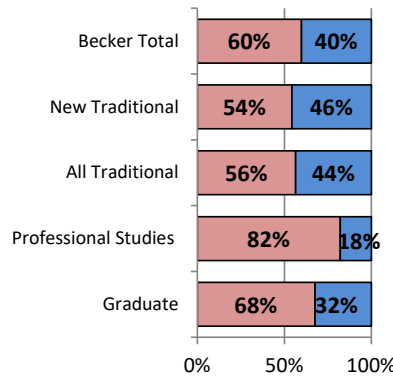

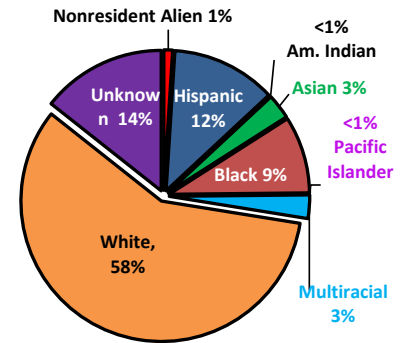

### Race/Ethnicity

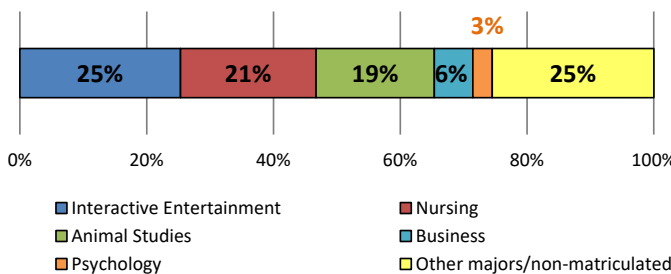

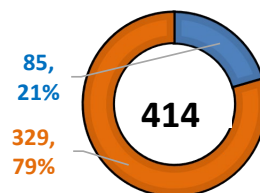
